

THE 3SI PLATFORM AS A LIFE-SUPPORTING SYSTEM FOR UKRAINE'S DEVELOPMENT

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In the current context of high global dynamics, security challenges and the urgent need for systemic modernisation, Ukraine needs an integrated infrastructure platform capable of ensuring socio-economic stability, sustainable development and international integration. The Three Seas Initiative (3SI) serves as such a platform - a system of national and international significance that integrates the key components of life support for the population and societal production.

The purpose of this article is to raise the issue of ensuring Ukraine's sustainable development under conditions of severe security and socio-economic turbulence. Particular attention is paid to the (3SI) as a forward-looking, systemic life-support platform that integrates key development dimensions - infrastructure, energy, digitalisation, social mobility and regional cohesion. The platform is examined as a strategic foundation for Ukraine's long-term resilience in the face of uncertainty.

The (3SI) platform is not just a coordination tool, but an institutionalised foundation for building a unified model of economic, social, security and infrastructure organisation. It focuses on meeting the basic needs of citizens, promoting sustainable development of territories, protecting vulnerable populations, enabling innovative renewal of the economy and ensuring adaptive responses to global challenges.

In this context, the structure of the (3SI) platform is fully in line with the logic of a life-support system, which includes

- Resources and their characteristics (human, material, financial, digital, managerial - form the resource base for the implementation of the mission);
- Subjects and objects of interaction (communities, companies, public authorities, NGOs, educational institutions - participants in the 3SI interaction);
- Institutions (norms, rules, agreements, digital protocols - ensure the legitimacy and sustainability of the platform's functioning);
- Processes (management, coordination, innovative production, social services, information exchange);
- Areas of activity (economic, humanitarian, educational, health, social, logistical, security);
- Subsystems - subsystems of health, education, social protection, public administration, digital services, inclusion and mobility.

The (3SI) platform is thus seen as a strategic life-support architecture and a platform for mobilising Ukraine's intellectual, institutional, resource and human potential to overcome crises and ensure sustainable development.
